



Selection of Top Priorities

- A. Single-County TSPLOST** – Reduce the required threshold for a valid intergovernmental agreement to cities making up 50% or more of the municipal population.
- B. Mental & Behavioral Health (*State & Federal*)** – Advance legislative, administrative, and funding changes to provide comprehensive mental and behavioral health services.
- C. Emergency Medical Services (*EMS*)** – Adjust EMS reimbursement rate policies to provide adequate funding to EMS providers.
- D. Housing Affordability and Accessibility (*State & Federal*)** – Develop meaningful solutions to address Georgia’s critical housing shortage.
- E. SDS/LOST Negotiations** – Create a better dispute resolution process for Service Delivery and Local Option Sales Tax Negotiations.
- F. Full Financial Responsibility for State Prisoners** – Increase the per diem rate for housing state prisoners.
- G. Soil Amendments derived by By-Products** – Increase the partnership between Counties and the Department of Agriculture to address violations.
- H. Digital Services** – Apply sales tax to digital rentals and subscriptions for tax parity.
- I. Next Generation 911 (NG911)** – Federal funding to assist with the implementation of NG911 from an analog system to a modern, digital, internet-based system.
- J. Property Tax Assessment and Appeal Reform** - Improve the property tax assessment process by removing the confusing estimate on the assessment notice and closing loopholes that allow commercial properties to pay taxes on a below-market value.
