Legislative Days 5-6

On Monday, January 23, the General Assembly returned to the Capitol for Legislative Day 5. There has been an increase in activity as bills have been filed and assigned to committee, and many committees held their first meetings. The majority of these meetings were organizational in nature with very few bills being considered. The Senate Judiciary Committee will utilize subcommittees this year, which is a change from the previous process.

The subcommittees of House Appropriations met Tuesday, January 24 (LD 6) to pass on their recommendations for <u>HB 43</u>, the amended budget for Fiscal Year 2017. The full House Appropriations Committee will meet on Wednesday, January 25.

Chief Justice P. Harris Hines will deliver the State of the Judiciary Address **tomorrow**, **January 25**, at 11 a.m. The address can be viewed live on the <u>House Video Broadcast Page</u>.

Both chambers stand adjourned until Wednesday, January 25, at 10 a.m. for Legislative Day 7.
