Legislative Days 5-6

After breaking for budget hearings last week, the General Assembly reconvened on Monday, January 28 for Legislative Day 5. Committees in both the House and Senate began meetings on Monday, with the Senate Judiciary Committee holding an organizational meeting to adopt the committee rules for the 2019-2020 session. On Tuesday, the Senate did not meet due to inclement weather; the House convened at 1 p.m., with the House Judiciary Civil Committee holding its first meeting in the afternoon.

Both chambers stand adjourned until Wednesday, January 30 at 10 a.m. for Legislative Day 7.
