WEEKLY LEGISLATIVE REPORT

February 26, 2021

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Week 7 (Legislative Days 20-24)

The General Assembly returned to session this past Monday, February 22 (LD 20) and met through all five days this week. During this time, many committee meetings were held, and a significant number of bills moved through the legislative process.

The House adopted a new adjournment resolution on Friday, February 26 (LD 24) which outlines the schedule for the remainder of the 2021 legislative session. Crossover Day (LD 28) will take place on Monday, March 8. Any bill that fails to pass out of its original chamber before the end of Crossover Day will be considered dead for the session. The final day of the session will be Wednesday, March 31 (LD 40).

[SB 163](#), which provides for tolling of statutory speedy trial requirements following a judicial emergency if compliance with such requirements is impracticable, passed out of Senate Judiciary Committee on Wednesday, February 26 (LD 22).

Both chambers stand adjourned until Monday, March 1, for Legislative Day 25. The House will convene at 10:00 AM, and the Senate will convene at 1:00 PM.
