

## HB 2015 schools; supplemental materials; approval (Fillmore)

Under current law, governing boards must approve basic textbooks, or in the absence of a basic textbook, all supplemental books to be used in a course before approving the course. If a course has an approved basic textbook, a teacher may use supplemental books that have yet to be approved, but they must be ratified by the governing board during that school year.

## **Provisions:**

- Requires a governing board to approve all supplemental books and teaching aids, including computer software, before approving a course.
- Prohibits a teacher from using supplemental books until the governing board approves of the material.
