

HB2109 unification; consolidation; notice, ballot language (Udall)

- Requires public notice to be posted 90 days in advance of a governing board vote on a school district consolidation or unification
- Increases, from 60 days to 100 days, the time in which a county school superintendent is required to call a special election for the purpose of establishing a unified school district
- Requires public notice to be posted at least 90 days before an election to establish a unified school district, or as soon as is practicable if the election is less than 90 days after the receipt of the petition to unify
