

HB 2125 districts; initiatives; litigation; prohibition (Thorpe)

- Prohibits a school district or other district created by law from maintaining an action to prevent the enactment of any initiative or referendum measure.
- Stipulates that the members of the governing body of a school district or other district are personally liable for the reasonable attorney fees and other costs of litigation incurred by people who attempt to enact the initiative or referendum measure.
- Retroactive to January 1, 2016
