General Information

The 2008 Drug and DUI Court Conference will provide educational training for Drug, DUI and Mental Health Court teams in order to help promote and improve the drug court system through best practices training.

On-site conference registration will begin at 2:00 PM, Monday, June 16, 2008. The conference program will begin at 8:30 AM, Tuesday, June 17, 2008. The conference will conclude at 1:45 PM on Thursday, June 19, 2008.

Lodging Scholarship Information

Lodging Scholarships will be given to Drug, DUI and Mental Health Court teams for five members per team, one for each member of the team. Only one team member per discipline will receive the scholarship. The scholarships will pay for lodging, but will not cover registration fees.

Teams within a 50 mile radius of the Wyndham Peachtree Conference Center are eligible for two nights lodging. Teams outside of the 50 mile radius are eligible for three nights lodging. Due to the proximity of the conference location, residents of Clayton, Coweta, Henry, Spalding and South Fulton are not eligible for lodging scholarships, but may request a waiver of the registration fee.

Each eligible scholarship recipient will be responsible for reserving his/her room on a credit card. Once checked-in, the room cost will be moved to the conference master bill. Attendees are responsible for covering their own incidental expenses.

Conference Registration Information

Early Bird registration for Georgia Drug/DUI/MH Court Teams (5 members eligible for lodging scholarships, but all team members qualify for reduced registration fee):

- **\$225 per person – Due by Tuesday, April 15, 2008**

Early Bird registration for Individuals:

- **\$300 per person – Due by Tuesday, April 15, 2008**

Regular registration for Georgia Drug/DUI/MH Court Teams (5 members eligible for lodging scholarships):

- **\$275 per person – Due by Friday, May 9, 2008**

Regular registration for individuals:

- **\$350 per person – Due by Friday, May 9, 2008**
