

About the Georgia Association of Secondary School Principals (GASSP)

The Georgia Association of Secondary School Principals (GASSP) is one of six educational leadership Departments affiliated with the Georgia Association of Educational Leaders (GAEL). Membership in GASSP is open to all persons engaged in practicing or teaching secondary school administration and /or supervision this state. Membership offers the opportunity to have a voice in areas that affect secondary education at both the state and national level. Members are eligible for the State and National Principal of the Year and Assistant Principal of the Year Awards, and dependents of members are eligible for the GASSP scholarship. GASSP is also affiliated with the National Association of Secondary School Principals.

The purpose of the association is to promote cultural and professional development among the secondary school principals among the secondary school principals in Georgia. The association attempts to stimulate a professional attitude among its members; accepts opportunities for assuming leadership in the various communities of the state and the state at large; encourages the scientific study of administrative problems; and influences legislation for the accomplishment of the organization's goals. The association seeks to organize the secondary school in such a manner that, in its relationship to elementary and middle education and to higher education, the entire educational process shall be a continuous and well-integrated whole.
