**POSITION: Behavior Specialist (RESA/GLRS)** 

## **Minimum Qualifications:**

- Master's degree and Certification in Special Education, School Psychology, School Social Work, or Educational Leadership
- Minimum of 5 years' experience working with students with conduct disorders, emotional and behavioral disorders or autism.
- Strong communication skills and ability to train other professionals and parents, if needed.
- Experience in leading system and school-wide interventions
- Experience in functional behavioral assessment, developing behavior intervention plans, and crisis prevention and intervention
- Experience in data collection and its use in program development and evaluation

## **Job Description:**

- Assists in developing procedures and training materials for all staff involved with students for the purpose of enhancing PBIS programs in schools.
- Conducts workshop, trainings, in-service presentations, etc. in classroom management techniques and other topics for the purpose of developing skills, managing behavior, and establishing effective relationships with all students.
- Coach classroom teachers and paraprofessionals on the implementation of PBIS in the classroom.
- Guide the teacher learning process toward working with student behavior and classroom management in order to better implement the personal learning plans (IEP's) of students.
- Work with individual teachers, groups of teachers, or the entire staff as well as district leaders on issues such as learning and collaboration, building relationships, sensory and behavioral issues, and other factors that can affect development and implementation of RTI and IEP's.
- Provide research based training to teachers, paraprofessionals, and other staff regarding behavioral data collection and analysis.
- Utilize data analysis to guide the use of behavioral support techniques.
- Assist systems that are disproportionate or in the at-risk category for disproportionality to develop policies and procedures, examine data, and implement appropriate intervention plans.
