Firefighters Recognition Day is set by law as the first Tuesday in February and provides an opportunity to recognize and pay tribute to our firefighting community. The ceremonies will officially be called to order at 2:30 p.m. During the ceremonies Georgia state elected officials will acknowledge and applaud contributions made by all fire service personnel in Georgia and also recognize and present commendations to award recipients of the Georgia State Firefighters Association, Georgia Association of Fire Chiefs, and Georgia Fire Inspectors Association. State Insurance Commissioner Ralph Hudgens also will deputize local fire marshals during this time.

4:30 p.m. - Home Fire Sprinkler Demonstration Trailer

Make plans to see a side-by-side demonstration is a highly effective learning tool used to present possible extreme fire hazards and show how residential and commercial sprinklers effectively limit those hazards. There is no more dramatic way to demonstrate the devastating speed and effect of flashover and the effectiveness of a Fire Sprinkler System. There are two "rooms"—both are furnished as a typical living room, bedroom or dorm room. The difference is that one of the rooms has a smoke alarm, while the other has a smoke alarm and a single fast response sprinkler head. This demonstration reveals the speed at which the fire sprinkler suppresses the fire in one room—usually under a minute—while the other room continues to burn and is already at flashover (the point at which everything in the room ignites) before a fire department typically arrives on scene. This demonstration is provided by the National Fire Sprinkler Manufacturers' Association.
