In the Coaching Conversations workshop, participants will learn and demonstrate a 5-step performance-based coaching process and four critical coaching skills.

GSSA's 1 PLU Coaching Conversations workshop consists of one highly-focused class offering 12 content hours, held in one 2-day session.

Throughout the course, participants will engage in activities that will include, but not be limited to, the following:

- Review current literature related to coaching.
- Demonstrate four coaching skills.
- Demonstrate the 5-step coaching process.
- Integrate the results of the Personal Coaching Styles Inventory (PCSI) into coaching practices.
- Write an action plan that focuses on two identified coaching skills.
