Art Contest #1:

- Target Audience: **Staff Members** (Any staff members that are employed by our member districts.)
- Each staff member can submit 5 pieces of artwork. Please do not submit anything that has sentimental value or you feel is priceless. We cannot take responsibility for this major type of artwork.
- Artwork must be in a frame, on a Styrofoam board, or on a canvas. (No glass and no poster board frame - Paper frames will not stand up without bending.)
- Huge consideration: If artwork gets stacked, will it be o.k.? Will it smear?
- Art must be school appropriate topics/themes. Audience viewers will be all ages.
- Names, schools, grades, school roles should be on the back of the artwork.
- Art submission - Sept. 19, 20 by 3:00 PM (If other arrangements need to be made, please email dana@hgresa.org.)
- Community viewing night - Sept. 30 (4:00-7:00)
- Pick-up date - Oct. 30 by 3:00 PM

Subject for Display: Lyrics from the Christmas song "The Twelve Days of Christmas"

Focus of Event: The HGRESA organization would like to display projects/artwork produced/created by students in our area. This is a fun way for creative students to display art works, similar to a float, but longer lasting.

Display Size: 4 feet by 8 feet (Please try to stay close to these parameters. Extensions can be made. HGRESA will "spotlight" the displays. Painting/drawing should be on a 4 X 8 feet piece of plywood. Designers can do vertical or horizontal, but horizontal seems to be easier to work with when displaying. The designers must create a stand for the display with safety as the focus! We do not want the display to fall on anyone.

Names: Please include name of district, school, and students on the display. Please include contact information (telephone and email).

Target Deadline: Thursday, December 5

Target Date for Announcement of Winners: Tuesday, December 10 by 4:00 PM

Special Notes:

- Create some wonderful memories and interject some friendly "art" competition among students.
- Adults should help the students transport the displays and maintain safety during the trip, please.
- Parents/School staff are encouraged to join in the fun and help.
- Please plan so that the display still looks great even if it rains.
- Displays can be picked up any time after December 27. **Displays not picked up by January 3 will be discarded.**
- Since this is an outside event, districts are free to work on the displays at any time. Please avoid parking on the street because of traffic flow. Please park in the circle driveway area when working on the display.
