JOHN P. IMLAY, JR. Chairman, Imlay Investments, Inc. and The Imlay Foundation

GOLDEN RULE AWARD

John P. Imlay, Jr. is Chairman of Imlay Investments, Inc., a private investment firm which manages capital and provides venture funds for small technology companies. He is also Chairman of The Imlay Foundation, a family foundation formed in 1989.

Imlay is the retired Chairman and CEO of Management Science America, Inc., among the top ten software companies in the world with 60 offices worldwide and over 12,000 customers. It was purchased by The Dun & Bradstreet Corp in 1989 and he remained as Chairman until he retired in 1996.

Upon selling the company, Imlay formed Imlay Investments and The Imlay Foundation. He is a minority owner of the Atlanta Falcons.

A Georgia Tech grad, Imlay received an honorary Doctor of Laws degree from Mercer University. In 1994 he was inducted into the Technology Hall of Fame for Georgia and in 1997 received the Entrepreneur of the Year Lifetime Achievement Award.

Imlay is author of the management book, <u>Jungle Rules</u>. He and his wife, Mary Ellen, reside in Atlanta.

THOMAS W. DORTCH, JR. Author, Entrepreneur, Community Activist

Thomas Dortch is Chair and CEO of TWD, Inc. In 1990, he became the first African-American State Director and served as Chief Administrator for US Senator, Sam Nunn. Other accomplishments include: President of South West Investment Group (SWIG), CEO of Atlanta Transportation Systems, Inc., Chair and CEO of Cornerstone Parking, and Chair of Lancor Parking Management, LLC. He established the National Black College Alumni Hall of Fame Foundation, Inc., co-founder of both the Georgia Association of Minority Entrepreneurs and the Greater Atlanta Economic Alliance.

Dortch has appeared on many television and radio shows, including Opera and Montel Williams, CNN. He is also the recipient of numerous awards and honors that celebrate his efforts. He serves on the Board of Leadership Atlanta; a board member of Grady Memorial Hospital, Chair of Friendship Force International and chair of the Fulton/DeKalb County Hospital Authority Board of Trustees. In 2010 he was inducted into Atlanta Convention & Visitors Bureau's Atlanta Hospitality Hall of Fame.

A much sought-after speaker, he has presented to numerous international and national corporations, government entities and educational institutions.

Dortch earned a B.A. Degree from "The" Fort Valley State University, and a M.A. Degree in Criminal Justice from Clark-Atlanta University in 1986. He also attended GSU as a Ford Fellow in the Urban Administration Program. Dortch received Honorary Doctors Degrees from numerous colleges and universities.
