## 2014 GOLDEN RULE AWARD

**BILL BOLLING, Founder and ED**  
**Atlanta Community Food Bank**

**Bill Bolling** is the founder of the Atlanta Community Food Bank and has served as executive director since 1979. He oversees the distribution of millions of pounds of good but unmarketable food and grocery products each year through a network of more than 600 nonprofit partner organizations throughout the southeast.

A frequent speaker on topics related to hunger, poverty, regionalism, affordable housing and public policy reform, his skills have made him a leader in strengthening the community to serve those most in need. Prior to the Food Bank, he was director of community ministries for St. Luke's Episcopal Church.

Bolling is a charter board member of Feeding America, and currently serves on numerous boards. He founded the Atlanta Housing Forum and past chair of the Regional Leadership Forum-now Regional Civic League and the state Housing Trust Fund Commission.

Bolling has received numerous awards and honors including the 2012 Georgia Trend "Georgian of the Year." He holds degrees from Central Piedmont College and Appalachian State University in Business and Education. He received his Masters in Psychology and Counseling from West Georgia College and attended Harvard Business School.

## "County Hallmarks: Georgia's Courthouses"

To mark its Centennial of service, the Association of County Commissioners of Georgia has developed the book **Courthouses of Georgia**, published by UGA Press in association with the Georgia Humanities Council.

The book features exquisite photographs of each of Georgia's 159 courthouses by Greg Newington, alongside historical text and architectural notes by Professor George Justice of University of North Georgia, a foreword by Ross King, and introduction by the Honorable Larry Walker of Houston County. The book reminds readers of people and events who have passed through the halls of these civic landmarks, and calls them to reflect on their significance as community anchors.

**Ross King** is Executive Director of ACCG-Advancing Georgia's Counties. He has been with the organization since 1987, serving as the association's policy director and deputy director prior to his appointment as executive director in 2010.

**Greg Newington** is a fine art and commercial photographer with a studio in the Serenbe Community of south Fulton County. Newington was previously the director of photography for Fairfax Business Media Group, Sydney Australia, and the photography editor for the Australian daily broadsheet.
