BRAD QUINLIN
"Georgia in the Civil War"

Brad Quinlin specializes Civil War battlefield trips, Civil War Re-enacting and spending years in the archives, museums and college libraries across the country. He has worked on many movie sets including *Gloria*, *Gettysburg*, *Perfect Tribute*, and *Gods and Generals*, and several TV shows including "Who Do You Think You Are" - where he showed Matthew Broderick the last three days of his great grandfather's life in the Atlanta Campaign. He is currently working on his own film about the Marietta National Cemetery which will air Memorial Day weekend.

Quinlin has written or co-written five books including, "Rest Brave Comrades Your work is done, letters from the Marietta National Cemetery", "On the Line of Bacon Creek" - "Duty Well Performed; the Civil War History of the 21st Ohio," and "Under the shadow of a grim and silent Kennesaw, letters from the Battle of Kennesaw Mountain." He is currently working on a book about the Atlanta campaign as well as an Andersonville book of letters from guards and prisoners.

Quinlin worked on the Kennesaw Mountain Battlefield film as the historical lead researcher and is now working on a project for them to ID every soldier that was on the battlefield in that hot summer of 1864. He has ID'd 49 unknown graves from the American Civil War in the Marietta National Cemetery. People from all over the US call on Brad to help them find the story of their Civil War Soldier.
