Alec Fraser is a volunteer spokesman for the Metro Atlanta Voter Education Network (MAVEN), a non-profit community organization that has been established to engage in non-partisan, non-advocacy educational activities regarding the Georgia Transportation Investment Act of 2010.

Fraser has had two unique careers. From 1996 to 2011, he was President of Turner Properties, a division of Turner Broadcasting System where he was responsible for overseeing the global facilities and security of all Turner properties worldwide including design and construction of the Turner and CNN sections of Time Warner Center in New York. Prior to joining Turner in 1996, Fraser completed 24 years in the United States Navy and is a graduate of the US Naval Academy, later serving as a ship captain on a destroyer and commanding officer of a guided missile cruiser. He has also been an on air military analyst for CNN.

Fraser has been an active member in the Atlanta Community. He has been President of the Rotary Club of Atlanta, Chairman of the Board of Trustees at Riverside Military Academy, Vice Chairman of the Atlanta Downtown Improvement District, and a member of the Executive Committee of Central Atlanta Progress. He is an Elder at the Peachtree Presbyterian Church.

He and his wife Sheila live in Atlanta. Their son is an investment banker in NYC for Deutsche Bank.
