Governor's Office of Workforce Development

Major General David R. Bockel is currently the Veterans Program Liaison for the Georgia Governor's Office of Workforce Development. He retired from the Army Reserve on June 6, 2003. He assumed his previous position as Commanding General, 90th Regional Support Command in June 1999. His prior assignments span an impressive record of military service since he first served in Vietnam in 1967 with units from the 25th Infantry Division and the 199th Infantry Brigade.

Bockel received numerous awards including the Distinguished Service Medal, Legion of Merit, Meritorious Service Medal with fourth oak leaf cluster, Army Commendation Medal with second oak leaf cluster, Army Reserve Components Achievement Medal with fourth oak leaf cluster, Vietnam Service Medal with second Bronze Service Star, National Defense Service Medal with Star (second award), Armed Forces Reserve Medal with Hourglass Device, Army Service Ribbon and others.

A graduate of the University of Alabama, Bockel also completed the Distinguished Military Graduate (ROTC); Quartermaster Officers Basic Course; Armor Officer Advanced Course; Signal and Transportation Officers Advanced Courses; the Army Supply Officer Course; Command and General Staff College; and the U.S. Army War College.

General Bockel and his wife, Jane, have two children and four grandchildren.

Sandra Mackey is a free lance writer specializing in the Middle East. She spent four years in Saudi Arabia where she reported on Saudi politics, economics, military affairs, and the society. Her many articles on the Middle East have appeared in the New York Times, the Los Angeles Times, the Wall Street Journal, and many more. She has also published several books including her most recent, *Mirror of the Arab World: Lebanon in Conflict*, in the spring of 2008.

Mackey is a frequent commentator on Middle East events on CNN; MSNBC; Fox; ABC Nightline and the Evening and many other media outlets. She has also appeared on a number of documentaries.

From 2004 to 2010, Mackey served as a lecturer in a program for the U.S. Army that prepared upper level officers rotating into Iraq. She travels often to the Middle East and has experienced many of the major world events in these areas.

Mackey holds an MA in international affairs from the University of Virginia and has taught political science at Georgia State University. She has served as a visiting scholar in the Woodrow Wilson Department of Government and Foreign Affairs at the University of Virginia. She lives in Atlanta, Georgia.
