

Please bring some of these items with you to the training for making manipulatives:

- old newspapers or restaurant advertisements
- magazines to cut out pictures (toy magazines, catalogs)
- math and reading workbook/worksheets – 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade
- shoe boxes with lids
- cardboard egg cartons
- empty water bottles with screw-on tops (12-16 oz.)
- small plastic containers with tops (e.g., pint freezer boxes, cool whip/margarine tubs)
- large containers with tops (e.g., coffee cans or large size pretzel containers)
- small containers for sorting items (yogurt cups, film canisters, etc)
- ziploc baggies (one quart and one gallon)
- small, clear plastic cups (1 dozen—small size)
- empty toilet paper rolls
- other assorted small containers, especially small boxes or styrofoam meat trays
