Access SLDS via link in SIS.


From Menu Bar click on PD-




PD Application will launch. From the "My Resources" tab, find *The Center for Leadership in Disability at Georgia State University*. Click on the number (there are 8 total) to open the sessions within that collection of professional development.




"My Resources" will show the title of each session within the module. Select a session by clicking on the name. That session will open in a new window. To assign it to your "My Progress", click "assign resource". This will save the session for viewing without searching. To add multiple sessions at one time, check the box located to the left of the title. Then select "Assign Resources" located on the bottom left.



Once "self-assigned" open "My Progress" to return to the modules by clicking on "Launch". Once a session has been completed, print a certificate of completion to add to your portfolio or other system.



After sessions in the module is completed, information from the module can be added to my transcript. In the "My transcript" area, any PD can be added not just ones taken from SLDS-PD application. This area is a great place to keep track of all professional development.
