GLASS provides accessible reading materials to Georgians who, due to a disability, are unable to read standard print.

## Fun facts:

- ▶ Talking books and magazines are delivered to your door, along with an accessible player.
- ▶ Tablet or smartphone owners can download audio or braille books and magazines through a free app: BARD Mobile.
- ▶ Our primary collection of books are narrated by humans, not text-to-speech robots.
- ▶ GLASS patrons can get free Bookshare accounts as adults! We also partner with PINES libraries to get you even more material, like large print books and audio described movies.
- ▶ Once you're registered, you're a member for as long as you'd like to be. We even connect you with talking book libraries in other states if you move.
