

# PRETAPP CANDIDATES

*This program is for individuals who have not secured a teaching position, but are interested in becoming a teacher.*

If you **have not been** offered employment with a Georgia school system, submit eligibility requirements documentation to Oconee RESA. GACE Program Admission Report or exemption documentation must accompany the Oconee RESA GaTAPP Candidate Application along with other admission requirement documentation.

## Eligibility Requirements:

- Completed Candidate Application
- Official College Transcript showing Bachelor's Degree awarded
- Proof of completion of GACE Program Admission Assessment or qualify for *exemption* with a passing score on the SAT, GRE, or ACT. You can also exempt the GACE Program Admission with a passing score on Praxis I, if you have taken test prior to September 1, 2006.

### Exemptions:

- SAT exemption: minimum combined verbal and mathematics scores totaling 1000;
- GRE exemption: minimum combined verbal and quantitative scores totaling 1030;
- ACT exemption: minimum combined English and mathematics scores totaling 43.
- Proof of completion of GACE Georgia Ethics Entry 350.

**Once completed applications are reviewed, candidates will receive an email from Dorothy Reynolds, GaTAPP Director listing content fields you are eligible to teach.**
