DOK AND RIGOR WORKSHOPS

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“DOK & Increasing Rigor for Teachers”

Are you teaching & testing at the rigor level of the standards? DOK helps to ensure alignment between standards & the correlating assessment items/tasks & classroom instruction. DOK is a four level scale that describes a common and shared language for rigor & cognitive demand in the classroom. After learning DOK, participants will gain knowledge on how to actually increase the rigor of instructional items & tasks. There will also be time to practice raising the rigor of sample items.

“DOK & Increasing Rigor for Leaders”

Are you a TAPS evaluator or academic coach & often wonder if the rigor in a teacher's lesson is appropriate for the standard being taught? Depth of Knowledge (DOK) for Leaders deeply explains complexity & how to apply the levels of DOK when using TAPS or evaluating informally. This session will strengthen your DOK skills & ability to conference with teachers since DOK is a common language for rigor. This training also shows you how to actually increase the rigor of instructional items & tasks, which will enhance the commentary you give teachers after an evaluation. Participants will practice applying the concepts of DOK to items/tasks in order to make assessments & lessons more challenging for the students based on the demands of the standard. School & district leaders are encouraged to attend as we work together to promote rigor for every student.
