This training will focus on the unique challenges of investigating and prosecuting the ever growing number of drug-impaired driving cases. The curriculum focuses on the cooperation between law enforcement and prosecutors as each learns more about how the other must proceed in a case.

The course is approved for <u>12 CLE credits</u>. Because of the hands-on nature of this training, the course will be limited to <u>20 prosecutors</u> and <u>20 law enforcement</u> officers.

The PDAI has partnered with the PA DUI Association in presenting this course. Through this partnership, the DUI Association will be offering Law Enforcement Scholarships to interested police officers who provide a short statement describing the challenges they face with DUI-D investigations and prosecutions in their jurisdictions.
